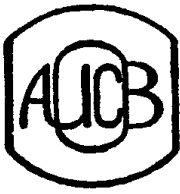
Subject: Allowing Deputation to Officers held up in Total lockdown, in nearby branch(s).

We understand that some Officers who had gone to their home on 21st March, 2020 or were on sanctioned leave could not return to resume their duties due to Janta Curfew on 22nd March and subsequent lockdown declared by Govt.

Some of these Officers are held up outside their State/Zone or at a considerable distance within Zone. Now since this lockdown has been extended to 3rd May, 2020, we request you to consider their request to allow them to join their duties on deputation to the nearest/nearby branches till 2nd May, 2020. Due to heavy rush being felt in most of the branches on account of DBT in customer's accounts, these Officers may share the burden of existing Staff. For those Officers who are held up Inter-State/Inter-Zone, you being the Competent Authority can help them by issuing their orders for deputation.

In case of Officers who are held up within Zone, suitable instructions may be issued to concerned Zonal Managers for taking care of them and doing the needful.

We also request you that Officers posted in Metropolitan cities too could be sent on deputation, more particularly lady Officers, to the branches near to their residence
