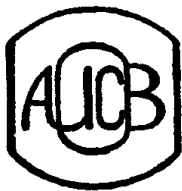
**Ref: Social Initiative by Unsung Warriors of Covid – 19**

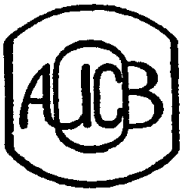
