Respected Sir,

Re: Deferment of ATE-2020 till improvement in Covid-19 pandemic

We refer to your letter NO. HRM/TPC/2020-21/94 dated 25-06-2020 conveying therein that due to prevailing conditions arisen due to Covid-19 pandemic in the country, Management has taken a decision to defer the ATE-2020 till situation eases out.

Sir, in this regard we are to apprise you that Officers are waiting impatiently to go back to their ZOD/ Choice Zone for a long time. In fact they start reverse counting from the DAY ONE they report in new transferee Zone. There are many Officers who are out of their Zone for 4 to 8 years. Sir, you will agree that there is a limit to the patience. Please do not test their tolerance anymore.

We concur with you that present time is very critical and no one knows as to what turn this Covid-19 will take in next few months. However, at the same time there can be a middle path which may assuage the feelings of affected Officers which are

deeply hurt. The provisional list of Incoming and outgoing Officers identified by you must be ready with you. This list may please be put under public domain so that Officers get some satisfaction that their name is in the list and as soon as situation improves their transfer orders will be issued. Simultaneously, Management should give an assurance that they will be reviewing the Covid-19 situation and take decision on implementation of ATE-2020 at the earliest.

Further on the transfer issue we are to make another request to you. We know that you have issued transfer orders of officers who were identified for transfer under ATE-2019 but their relieving was defeated by 1 year on their request. These Officers have been instructed to report to their new transferee Zone by 30-06-2020. We request you to cancel their transfer order.
